She is Director of the SPRING Project, a CFS- sponsored outreach initiative which offers affordable psychotherapy for expectant and postpartum mothers and their families in New York City, New Jersey, Baltimore and Washington, D.C. She has published papers contributing to a psychoanalytic understanding of female psychology.

Dr. Helen K. Gediman is Adjunct Clinical Professor of Psychology at the New York University Postdoctoral Program in Psychotherapy and Psychoanalysis where she is also a Training and Supervising Psychoanalyst. She is a member and Training and Supervising Psychoanalyst at The Contemporary Freudian Society in both its New York City and Washington D.C. Programs. She is also a member of The Institute for Psychoanalytic Training and Research (IPTAR); The International Psychoanalytic Association (IPA); The Confederation of Independent Societies of the IPA (CIPS), and The American Psychoanalytic Association (APsaA) Dr. Gediman has published extensively in refereed psychoanalytic journals and in psychoanalytic books. A sampling of her over 65 papers and presentations will be forthcoming in the book Building Bridges: The Selected Psychoanalytic Papers of Helen K. Gediman to be published by International Psychoanalysis.
